2) Pigfarm: Income from sale of pigs and also food for the school.

3) Biogas: Free and clean gas to the kitchen. No smoke and the school will save money because they do not need firewood and chakos. We also save the forest.

4) The fertilizer from this plant and the irrigation will give the school more vegetables throughout the year.
